## **HEVRUTA ASSIGNMENT**

## 1. A Game of Fours

The poem is, mostly, very symmetrical. Note how each stanza has four lines, and each line has four beats. Bracket the fifth stanza (S5) for a moment. How do S1-4 divide? If two and four are the organizing scheme of the poem, what do you make of S5, which breaks that pattern?

- 2. What is the meaning of שוב לפניי? What kind of mental or physical event is being introduced by these words?
- 3. Each stanza—again, except for the fifth—describes a central image. What is that image for each stanza, and is there a progression among them?
- 4. How do you parse the title of the poem?

## PREP ASSIGNMENT FOR SEPT. 19

- 1. Practice the proper pronunciation of the poem and be prepared to read aloud. For Sept. 26, you will be asked to memorize and enunciate the first three stanzas.
- 2. Prepare the poem; look up words you don't know. Think about the ending: Does the last sentence have closure?
- 3. We are going to focus on the dynamics of literary allusion. Bring to class either a full Tanakh or have the equivalent on your laptop.
