Important points raised — use these as my own point-of-departure

1. Differentiated response to the Hol

- affecting diff groups in diff ways
- in each group: giving rise to new, unanticipated problems

ISRAEL

a) Period of Statehood 1948-61 deliberately downplayed survivors, tho 10% of pop., not at center of consciousness
1948-51 still pt.
 weren't allowed to mourn our losses; German Reparations
 (Tel) Ben-Gurion was right

b) Eichmann Trial → Yom Kippur War

first public occasion for bearing witness, mourning
 unlike USA, where public focused on Eichmann,
 pathology of evil —

Israel focused on the witness
 (Harrower) Katznelson flinched

Wars: heightened sense of déjà-vu
 particularly on eve of 6-day war
 psychological reflex: unleashed the collective trauma

c) Present

(Wieseltier) our politics paralyzed by our knowledge
 of the past

H. stands in the way of effective analysis, action
 (Tel) religious fanatics invoking the Hol to further
 their apocalyptic world-view
~~declaring holocaust~~.

USA/Canada

Rapidly becoming center of diaspora Jewry's self-identity
 displacing Israel

Israel is exogenous

Hol is ours (Friedlander)

(Mankowitz) Galutization of Israel — portraiture state
 in perennial position of isolated vulnerability

Non-Jews

terrible broke/brek setting in
heady period of ecumenical embrace is over
(cf my own experiences)

(Wiesel) Hol. encourages anti-S
makes unthinkable entirely possible

(Levine) Cudihy's new book

(Friedlander)

rise of neo-Fascism Gréc

systematic attempt to discredit the documents
inversion of images

Jews → symbol of Evil

Nazis were tricked

② The SURVIVOR

- whole session devoted to psychoanalytic treatment
- is their personal trauma a matter of public policy?
- Yoram Kaniuk's Adam Resurrected (= Marxist/Sade)
- by dwelling on their pathology, are we not dehumanizing them further?

My Own Contribution

EVENT

predicated upon uniqueness of the Hol.

we dare not even utter the designated word

<Hol. commission report>

so ineffable, that like name of God, can be invoked
only by double euphemism

∴ unique

∴ unknowable, except by someone who has been there

Mystical Landscape

concentrationary universe

Hol. kingdom

Wiesel

most prominent witness among us

only someone who has been there has right

own experience → theology of paradox

∴ his presence, person eclipse Event itself

A Double Dif. - cult of the survivor

- thesis of double death

- even disabled

- mystically endowed;

- actually lived thru Hell

∴ more imp than real victims

- they couldn't have apprehended

- memoirs better than diaries

myth → ~~the~~ history

survivor → murdered millions

lit. of survival → lit. of the Hol.

Why this is wrong

survival is individual experience

Hol. is not

Judaism never singled out the indiv. as worthy of commemoration

We have no Saints Days

Even if we did: a saint is dead!

we're about to create a new Christology religion and a Christological one at that!

survivor-as-witness - sacrifice - Everyman

hardenedness

their testimony as Scripture

The pain is great - there is no denying that

but we have been here before

a great deal to be learned from past experience

that is why I'm here today
