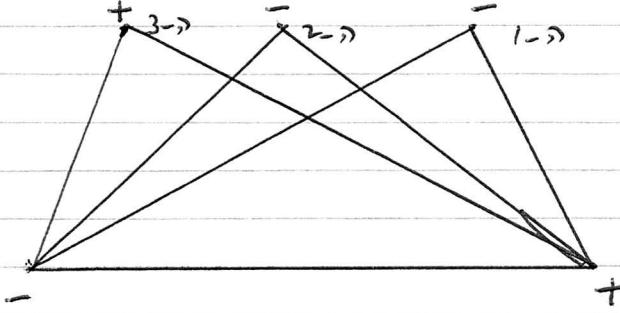

2 variant published in 1580 mentions that Miller's wife was pregnant. Robbers want the foetus because a candle made from the hand of a male foetus has magical powers, esp. to become invisible. D 1410.2

Her Structure

- 1 positive hero who has our sympathy - wife
 - 2 negative hero - husband
 - 3 initially neutral hero → active, positive - brother



- original structure of type III in which + fights - by asking for three voices, one of which is a cry for help.
 1. antagonists : + groom or bride vs - Angel of death
 2. 3 helpers : 1. - father (mother, parents); 2 - (brother, sister); 3. + bride (groom, mate)

Type I : no helpers, the girl wins in battle

Type II : by pleading for mercy from the robber

Type it : by calling for help.

205 - later variants:

- 1. opponents are girl (+) vs robber-murderer (-)
 - 2. the last helper (+) is her brother
 - later as many as 7 or 13 helpers can be added
 - in the end, saved by God
