While reading the "Jewish Times", a weekly periodical, in Balt., Md., I noticed this item of yours discussing the "skit", fact and fiction, on the Eternal Light program.

I was struck by your last name — ROSKIES — which differs by one letter from mine — ROSNES —. My father had come from Lotzke or Looz in Poland to the U.S. about 1905 or 1906. No other Roskes's existed in this country — to the best of my knowledge, except for my father's nephew and niece — both deceased — Wolf Roskes⁽¹⁾ and DR. SARAH ROSKES⁽¹⁾ residents in New York. While in Israel, my mother found ~~one grandchild~~^{the grandson} of my father's brother, I believe Shalom ROSNES. His name is Zigmars Roskes⁽¹⁾.
