Family name: Fremde

Dr. Baum

Now he knew who he was = building the wall

Polyphony of the beggars (28-19)

Purim Party (18-39)

Loaf of rationed bread in front of grandfather

Grandfather impersonates God (31-35)

German rips up the mezuzah (novel ends w/same mezuzah)

1st use of unmerged German

Aunt Chava arrested for her act of protest

Ends w/terrible raid/pogrom in their own home

Complete desecration/sacrilege

II. (41-62) Building the Wall

Father closes up his upholstery shop forever

Children find 1st corpse

Cries of the bricklayers

Differentiated response of his parents

Father's failed attempt to smuggle food

Anatomy of hunger; reverie of bread (47)

Nathan Lerch selling his rations door-to-door

Wearing the armband: brilliant anatomy (49)

Howling of the loudspeakers

Bloody Hands

Father davening

SMUGGLING

View from the Bridge

The Polonized lawyer who reverts to being Szwarc

View from the Bridge (will be destroyed @ end)

Voice of Buba the street vendor

Germans inspecting the wall - Czerniakow

Reb Yitskhok forced to do punitive exercises

Crescendo of shouts & cries (61)

Ends w/Father telling him not to speak or breathe

III. (63-87)

Barukh Ok's gang

Flashback to Sukkes

Yankiel the Tailor comes pleading for carbide = narrative frame

Refugees tell of the Final Solution

Elijah the madman from Leszno

Father's refrain: Shh, shh. . .

Forced relocation to the Small Ghetto

Excursus on time (77-78)

Father's mobilization & escape from labor camp

Last prewar walk with father to the ZOO

The rubber tubing on father's rickshaw

Ends w/David's nightmare about bread/lice

IV. (89-110)

Mordechai the COACHMAN

REFRAIN: Mordechai, toss it here (the horse speaking!)

Children's curses

Count Grandi: Before/After; abandons Malka after her typhus

2nd refrain: I buy crusts & stale bread

David conjures up a meadow for Leibush's benefit

Watery soup vs. Manna in desert 3rd refrain: Rakhmunes, rakhmunes

David's chronicle of the courtyard

Children's games

Leibush the visual artist. Comes down w/typhus

Old Zelda

"Regina, Regina, add water!"

Tailor pleads w/David to read letters

V. (111-130) The Three Holy Men: Mock-covenantal

Biblical lamentations, prophecies

Elijah the Corpse Man

David's gang

Beggar trying to steal holy man's alms

Mordarski the Merchant

Leibush recovers

Mock refrain: It will be counted

Incantation of Bread (126)

Estusia the Whore (=Esther?)

Janitor goes mad when daughter dies; hacks Mordechai's horse to pieces

Devoured by the yard

Ends w/proleptic passage about Great Deportation

VI. (131-55) Sukkes; almost-lyrical

Tailor's daughter writing from sunny Palestine vs. plight of the refugees

Terrifying figure of Long Yitskhok

Dr. Obuchowski, the selfless doctor, inspects their festering wounds

You celebrate sukkes all year long

David trading Madagascar stamp

Malka the Whore before/After

Mother's soliloguy on makeshift sukkot

Father's naïve faith vs. mother's ironic sensibility

Their comic joint reverie

Long Yitskhok steals from everyone; gang steals from the weak

Voices of the beggar market

Killing cats for food; pursued by Long Yitskhok

Ends w/boys on the bridge

VII. (157-89) David smuggles fresh bread from Aryan Side

Fist fight between Avrum / David

Haskiel the Janitor & Riva

Remorseful David mourns for the dead past & present (162)

Collective German monologue filtered thru David's consciousness

Chaim shot dead

David trying to conquer his fear

Zyga, master smuggler

Mock **Akedah** (168-69)

His Jewish nose / discovers his uncle Shmuel on Aryan Side

Caught by Bloody Hands

Ghetto lore vs. German songs

Mezuzah-as-talisman for smuggling

VIII (191-210) Lessons w/Dr. Baum

Photo of simkhes Torah

Dr. Baum's heaven & Hell = pure astronomy; where freedom reigns

Hell = Scorpio

David steals bread for himself; terror of the gendarmes

Covenantal world collapses in face of Baum's scientific approach (199)

Last Letter = the Final Solution (203)

Crematorium / gas chamber = pillar of fire & pillar of cloud (204)

David's Existential angst

Hunger-as-metaphor-for his art (208-9)

Hunger consumes him as he falls asleep

IX. (211-40) Patriarchal Narrative Redux; JONAH

Schwarz tries unsuccessfully to bribe Father

Grandfather as center of consciousness

Discussion w/Dr. Baum

Grandfather to David: live in order to run away (231); have a heart of stone

Assumes mantle of prophecy himself (231-32) A dessiy or a cure HC 1339

Semi-wakeful nightmare of being caught

Ends w/confession of Long Yitskhok stealing his bread

David falls asleep

X. (241-70) Warsaw as Nineveh

David returning home from other side

Natan Lerch the violinist

Warsaw as Nineveh = City of Debauchery

Ends w/mass fornication

Halka the Whore as center of consciousness

Becoming a Writer = Learning to Survive on Aryan Side (254-56)

Learning to distinguish each/every person

Learning to be completely self-reliant

Be moved by their human effort but remain apart

Bravery = desire for life = struggle for food (257)

Elijah the Grave Digger picks up Long Yitskhok's corpse

Malka will be next

XI (271-93) Hallucinatory Chapter

David contracts typhus

Refrain: Stone on stone (children's game)

Jacob's ladder

Passover

Find dead Grandfather in rate-infested apt.

Aunt Chava goes mad & disappears

XII (295-321) Stealing gold teeth & silver bridges from the dead; the deal that goes awry

Old Jew's extended Kaddish over the open grave

REFRAIN: German chatter & ridicule & curiosity

Photograph the child grave robbers

Ernst murdered by the fence

Opposite rhythms from earlier chapter

XIII (323-44) The Great Deportation begins

1st mention of Umschalgplatz (325)

Easier for rats for no one has proclaimed Rattenrein

Boisterous procession of the street gangs to their death

Mordarski's family shot dead; Sura the street vendor too

Bloody hands comes into his own

Rojzele dressed up for the journey; Haskiel Ajzen too

murder of all patients & doctors

Count Grandi, now a Jewish policeman, aiding the roundup Shot for refusing to execute his father Janitor's family walks off Lewin's refusal to give a bribe = act of protest Mordarski's demonic commandment (339) Nahum Szafran Mother rounded up Prof. Baum, too

XIV (345-61)

Holfe's speeches of a Judenrein world = Communist rhetoric of 1968 Jews run the world (355)

Orchestration of voices going to their deaths

lone voices calling for armed revolt Reb Yitskhok = KH

Bloody hands rounds up all the black coats (=kapotes)

XV (363-402) The Last Hideout; Liquidation of Little Ghetto

Father leaves; will never be reunited

Pillar of Fire in Hebrew (374)

Mordarski: Money replaces bread as currency of survival Nahum Szafran, the stoolpigeon flushes out remaining Jews Proleptic passage on Zelda's death @ hands of Bloody Hands Kalman killed

*Use of mezuzah as pass secret message that Yehudah had crossed over Landscape of absolute extremity (389)

Uri makes it across

2 versions of Mordarski's death

Estusia goes mad

Ingesting the images like inhaling oxygen

Wearing a number he joins a shop

Seeing his home for last time

Shop becomes a KL

Ends w/David going off to forced labor as last stragglers are rolunded up

MYTHIC underpinning = Biblical and countercovenantal Writing a New Bible, as Primo Levi commanded Vast orchestration of voices, until they are all silenced Unity of Place

I-VI: Genesis to Exodus; Patriarchal Narrative

VII-XII: David, the Smuggler; Jonah

XIII-XV: Apocalypse
