1924 - Highmount (in Catskill Park Preserve)

136 pink > how tent, not house, primitive, bathing in beauty of sun etc.
eyes wandering over the hills in the horizon, as if she is trying to retrieve
dreams from them

Pecan: one hand on faithful dog, one on Book of Books, caught in
reverie, another addresses visitors

Intro to a monologue, all about her voice (hoarse, male voice)

92, straight back, erect, clear eyed:

list of daily tasks she performs herself (tiring to hear!)

[proto-feminist notions of productive work + connection to land, the active life,
non-intellectual and domestic centered - This is the supplement to
Signist reality, which is irreverent + unconnected to tradition]

Anti-urbanized: City folk: arrogant, pre-aged even as young.

137 In 1928 her job o' O'N > retain - testimony, authority, witness,
monopolizer of discourse

Fountain of

Pilgrimage site, how paragon, apophysis, a source of wisdom + advice

Already in 1924, this country life is deemed totally lost + alien to

the young city dwellers - idealization of a standard, a lost norm

[We know how much domestic violence, mental illness, poor
education, stratifying factors, + suspicion of education was native
to rural life, but none of that is hinted at here]

Their desire is cannibal: secret of youth, stories of Golden Times,
amusing tales about ancient ones

Her response: demystification, no secrets: plain hard work in nature
- same truth that has never varied from Adam + Eve

Ref to Adam + Eve confirms Edenic fix - no mortality, longevity,
beauty, plenty, happiness

Scorū (ālatMaiwūnūd): you race, compete, chase your sunset then ask about the secret of life - all plains + open

Speech end w/ formulaic Then spoke Mā (Gander - GaNhaNuska)

- 138 One-time curiosity about big city - 1863 bro. wounded -
chook + meat in streets - city fix in her mind at that moment:
PINDI → 3FINDI → PINDI

Death for her as animal, being called home by Good Father -
life in the meantime before death as dear + beautiful

Alone, solitary American wif - where are her children?
friends in hills, valley, flowers, all familiar

- 139 Princely, the dog, 7th generation of loyalty - record of loyalty,
protection, help - lifelong + buried on the slope of the hill near husband
Beauty + hard work leave no room for loneliness [not work or love]
Shut in during winter storms: tranquil, w/ dog + animals

140 And her memories - self-sacrifice

Admits to being emotional at the locals' house - has outlived them all
memories from childhood w/ the young - riding + trekking -

Red Indian Wars - happy endings - dressed up, war feathers, war paint -
patriotism, song + anthems - war w/ Sioux, clinked on head by her -

Golden days, endless, happy, active, even school, family, S branch

- 142 the Miss Virginia Clark - the best! education by stories, mythologys
about Pocahontas, pioneers, George Washington, battle acted out -

- 143 British + Americans, but we one wanted to play the British
Sundays: Robert because of Bible stories father recd to family;
no church, too isolated - school/home division

Bible 1850 > repetition of figure underscores Biblical typology - her life
as being lived in Biblical terms -

God's love can only be found in the Book or in these hills

Purity is organized religion w/ its social motives, entertainment,
social display

[Jesus mentioned only to synagogue in list of other houses of worship]
Similarities of denominations mean nothing to her - goes to all
weddings + funerals - God could never fathom differences among them.
God gave streams + woods + fields as if to say: Look at them &
even my ways + find Me in the world - given to all + Angels
here is my beloved book [an assumption of plain + resonant
meaning + teaching]

15 This abundance is available to all to take

Conclusion: from her crowd outside to drink at well where
Jacob + Rachel met (but no stone on top)

Ends w/ the guests being ~~wanted~~ give single food of hospitality
as out of the Bible

Taylor's genre that militates against discord, fulfillment
no connection to world of author/poet, unless he is among young listeners -
Book of Books + Book of Nature as whole + perfect

The presentation of a type, not the whole world, not a social landscape -
moment of America, pre-industrial, piety, transcendentalism,
anti-institutional - altogether

OT/Ab. Bible: her faith totally devoid of Christology (only single Testament)
most primitive Christianity - before dogma, natural religion seems barely
molded by a Book religion -
