Ackerman: appreciation + critique of Borsdorff Boys over

for ideological reasons that played into the hands of key concession

subject matter" w/ little or no present meaning for the child "but, is the  
development of the student's potential capacity to function  
actively + effectively in the reconstruction of the social order"

Problem was that amid ~~so~~ much functionalism (brought on  
by push for standardization) the envisioning of such an order (in  
Jewish terms) was never realized

Rand, 433: ambivalence - feared day school as preparing Jews ~~not~~ for survival only in large ghetto & not giving them the intended freedoms to be Jews, yet awareness of the anti-Jewish impact of the public school (Dushkin) - also, possible fear that the "tolerance" of Am. society would not stretch this far
