 - (f) Let me know whether the Thomas quote on page 39 is needed. If so, we will still have to ask for permission. Please advise.

If we can lick these problems we can go ahead. I am hopeful it will be possible.

Please let me know whether you can pick up your items from here. I have already started on mine.
