Lotman et al Semiotics of Russian Culture - History

- can lit unlock a society's quest for identity?
- choice of text will already predetermine what ques / ans we seek
- nothing "Jew" about Kafka
- only Jew character is Mendel in Amerika
- despite his passionate interest in Heb/Jid lit
- Lucien Goldman - the better the novelist the less his overt relationship to the society he inhabits (Sociology of the Novel)
- e.g. lack of def time/place in Kafka's fiction?
- does this have any Jew. meaning?
- Robert Wyman (E-German rezeptionstheorist): "Past significance & Present Meaning"
- pre-1945 / post- 1945 Kafka are 2 distinct writers
- plays diff function once we read it as realistic ↔ fantomagorical

Semiotic def of Jew. lit

e.g. of Roth's Job

hero is a "lehrer" which can only mean 3N/N
untranslatable concept of a marginal person

The heroic decision to write for a minority (Brenner) ↔ decision to write for fellow assimilated Jews & culture at large

Berdichewsky's "שׁדָּה"

- hero cursed by the "shadows" he tries to cast off
- wrestling with those shadows reveals how strong their ties still were
- Heb lit prolonged the struggle

- Self-hatred a function of JESEN JON
- collective punishment as factor ideology
- to be a Jew = be in state of exile
- provide a justification for your own extermination
- ∵ Jew as cockroach ∴ he should be exterminated
- guilt for being what you are
