

- Rwitch made typewritten copies of both letters!

- had moved his shop to Bucharest; his sister Shagrdl lived there too, married to a weaver named Vulke Glazman

Bildl recalls an incident in 1920/21 when he offered M a job in a store belonging to a Lász - Zsuzsi. M. terribly insulted. wanted to live from poetry alone

TMZh 30 March 1969: spoke at SA's gathering in Czernowitz (1919)

- he had just arrived there from Jersey; wanted an audience for his ballads!
- Poete Zion 6.11.25 is pub his 1st ballads
- Chairman was Bundist leader Berl Friedman
- spoke so faintly (about 15.10.16 ~~dragger~~) that no one could hear him
- his lifelong childish talents
- his mother died in mid 1920s - leg paralyzed in Jersey before he arrived

1921 when no one ~~could~~ hear him

marries Rokit in 1933 tries to arrange his life; marvel at his elegantly packed valise
silk ties, ironed shirts, dark suit

- Photo of his visit to Kimpolung (Bukovina) Aug 1937 - Fried Weiniger, Rokit, Piner
German-Jew. poet Alfred Margul Spicker (d. 1967) - trans. M in Czernowitz press
- Weiniger dedicated his 1st book of poems (1936) to Mányó
- Anersbach pub. reportage of his visit in Wessman (1937) - 0/15

NYC 1951 1st visit to Ferrel 1958

1910s-1920s

Saves folksong for last; builds a literary genealogy from MC, learned society; people who, because of their love of Yiddish & poetry, open themselves up to irony, satire, the folk. Portrayal of **Hasidism** - very negative.

- 1) Akensfeld's, Gottlob's, Perl's anti-Hasidic satires; their bitter experience fighting it
- 2) Hershele Ostropoler vs. Reb Borukh!


Very strong sense of **LANDSCAPE**: Worms, Berlin, Odessa, Zamość, Rumenia, Galicia = Yiddish as tied to עײַנלעך

En = dramatic vignette; usually picks up on the character in old age or in a moment of intense introspection (e.g. Isaac Walich, Birkh Shaffir)

Personification of Yid. lit: intensified after the Hol. < cf. p. 190 >

Hidden Polemic

- a) Soviet radical flattening according to class; here there is no class antagonism whatsoever; the Yid. maskilim are ipso facto progressive; only workers' poet is mad
- b) Palestinian Zionist flattening: only the ur-historical landscape is real



Mary + Rachel Amerbach / Note

had M.D. Waterhouse write Rewitch 13.9.45

- had just seen Rachel "who seems very worn out" - & he offered her to do anything she wishes - and she seems to wish to be alone. to do her writing & she advises him not to return to Poland altho she wishes to. She says she has no ambition but to write & cannot wait on him - he is a man who needs continual writing on -

I know it is eccentric of him to ask me to write but he is eccentric & impossible to judge by ordinary standards.




