The hard covered volume is of regular size and contains 212 pages and 2 unnumbered pages. The forward is on pages VII-XII. The collection is on pages 5-242. The contents are on pages I-VI.

The part of the book dealing with Chelm is called "Khelemer Naronim" and is on pages 187-210.

The book is in good condition.

There is a detailed table of contents with footnotes. There are pictures of pages from books.

Each Khelemer tale is titled. There is little mixture of language used in the tales.

The author uses footnotes for linguistic purposes and to tell us variants of some stories. He tells us the place where the variant was told and/or the person who told it. The collector tells us the name and birthplace of correspondents who sent him many of the tales. He also tells us the geographical location in which some of the tales were told. The collector does very little comparing to tales told by non-gews.
