Nosn - Note Cohen - recently widowed, in charge of his children
 Henekh - demobilized from Red Army; returns home to die
 Esther - in Kharlov; returns home to rejoice at his funeral

① War - revolution - hunger

no food for sabbath

mourns his wife

rift between fathers/suns

Mott Pikelne - local Bolshevik

fathers → 1921 letter to son

② Noz & Gob (1921)

Ideological $\frac{\text{✓}}{\text{✗}}$ between bourgeoisie / proletariat supplants spiritual
 $\frac{\text{✗}}{\text{✓}}$ → forced to sweep the streets on Noz

Henekh returns home sick

④ Mott / Gurland

⑤ Mott - Hanzh / Henekh

⑥ Henekh on river bank - naked girls eat bacon & he thinks only of death

⑦ Shul-yidn try unsuccessfully to rope Mott into minyan
new "collective" vs old (minyan)

⑧ Mott / Henekh³ - get stoned
 erotic bond with Hanzh emerges

⑨ Father - Hanzh mourn Henekh's illness

⑩ Henekh recovers // pogrom imminent

→ Hanzh with father too joyous to mourn

- (11) Fear & trembling in eve of pogrom
premonition of death
- (12) Pogromists sighted
- (13) Moll's victory
- (14) Harmony restored - Moll acclaimed hero // Henekh dying
- (15) Henekh's death & burial

Esther returns - will not take cognizance of the corpse
sh'tell jubilant - father grieves (= rev. of (10))
