Focus on family

Nosn - Note Cohen - recently widowed, in charge of his children

Henekh - demobilized from Red Army; returns home to die

Esther - in Khar'kov; returns home to rejoice at his funeral

① War - revolution - hunger

no food for sabbath

mourns his wife

rift between fathers/sons

Motl Pikelne - local Bolshevik

fathers → 1.11.22 letter to son

② AOD 16.10.22

Ideological → 3.2.22 between bourgeoisie/proletariat supplants spiritual

3.2.22 → forced to sweep the streets on AOD

⑧ Motl / Henekh³ - get stoned erotic bond with Hanzh emerges

⑨ Father - Hanzh mourn Henekh's illness

⑩ Henekh recovers // pogrom imminent gossiped with father too joyous to mourn

- ⑪ Fear & trembling in eve of pogrom
premonition of death
- ⑫ Pogromists sighted
- ⑬ Mott's victory
- ⑭ Harmony restored - Mott acclaimed hero // Henekh dying
- ⑮ Henekh's death & burial
